*Note.* In the first year, PhD and PsyD students take the same courses and thus their first year costs are identical. Students are not accepted for part-time study. Student government fees are \$36/quarter in Fall, Winter, and Spring, and \$24 in Summer. In 2012-13, 96% of first year students applied for financial aid; 90% were awarded grants of \$5,280; 74% accepted federal student loans averaging \$23,846. Three first year students received multi-year fellowships of \$10,000 for each of the first three years in the program, and four students from underserved populations received a single-year awards of \$5,000 each. In addition, more than \$300,000 in fellowships and scholarships were awarded to returning students, including 20 fellowships totaling \$290,000 and 31 scholarships totaling more than \$76,000.
