# Overview of School of Psychology

- We offer three degree programs in our SOP
   Master's of Science in Marriage and Family Therapy (MSMFT)
  - - Completed in 2-3 years (depending on your track preference)
      Pasadena or Arizona in-person study
      Meets requirements for Licensure

  - PsyD in Clinical Psychology
     Completed in 5 years
     In-person study (first 4 years, internship placement 5th year)
    - APA Accreditation
  - PhD in Clinical Psychology
    Completed in 6 years

    - In-person study (first 5 years, internship placement 6th year)
       APA Accreditation

#### Admission Requirements

#### **MSMFT (Marriage and Family Therapy)**

- Accredited bachelor's degree (4-year program)
- Official transcripts from all post-secondary academic work (3.0 GPA)
- Religious Autobiography Questions, parts A and B
- Statement of Purpose
- Strongly Recommended Psychology coursework
- 4 References; 1 pastoral & at least 1 academic
- Online Application; \$75 application fee
- Fall 2019 Application Deadline: February 15th, 2019
  - Fuller.edu/Apply



#### Admission Requirements

#### PsyD & PhD (Doctoral level degrees)

- Accredited bachelor's degree (4-year program)
- Official transcripts from all post-secondary academic work
- Prerequisite coursework
  - 6 total courses (receiving letter grade of B- or better)
    - Behavioral Science Statistics course (within last 5 years)
    - 5 Psychology courses (within last 10 years)
- Religious Autobiography & additional essays
- 4 references; 1 pastoral & 3 academic
- GRE (Take by October), PGRE for non-psych majors
- Resume
- Online Application; \$75 application fee
- Fall 2019 Application Deadline:
  - November 1st, 2018 (Early deadline), Application fee waived
  - **December 1st, 2018** (Final deadline)

#### Financial Aid

- Need-Based (Charles E Fuller, FAFSA) and Merit-Based Scholarship (program specific)
- Applicants are considered for scholarship based upon their admissions application
- Returning students may receive more scholarship in subsequent years
- Estimated cost per program
  - MSMFT \$47,430/\$50,160
  - o PsyD \$129,100
  - o PhD \$158,220
