## *The History of Fuller Theological Seminary*

---



In the mid-1940s, radio evangelist Charles E. Fuller was reaching thousands through his popular broadcast, *The Old Fashioned Revival Hour*. But he dreamed of spreading the gospel even further: through a new school on the West Coast that would train young evangelists and missionaries.

Harold John Ockenga, theologian and pastor of Boston's Park Street Church, shared Fuller's vision but encouraged him to broaden it. The church needed not only evangelists, he said; it also needed pastors who were intellectually sound and culturally attuned as well as solidly evangelical.

The combined vision of these two led to the founding in 1947 of Fuller Theological Seminary—named not for Charles E. Fuller but for his father, Henry Fuller. This “center for evangelical scholarship” welcomed its first class of 39 students, who met in the Sunday school rooms of Lake Avenue Congregational Church, sitting in child-sized chairs as they learned from a charter faculty of theological giants: Everett Harrison, Carl F. H. Henry, Harold Lindsell, and Wilbur Smith.



The student body grew rapidly in subsequent years, and in 1953, the seminary—with enrollment now at 250—moved to the newly constructed Payton Hall on Oakland Avenue, its first and now iconic building at the center of the Pasadena campus. In the 76 years since its founding, Fuller Theological Seminary has become a place of rich diversity and theological leadership beyond what its founders could ever have imagined. Two schools covering four major disciplines—theology, missiology, psychology, and marriage and family therapy—allow Fuller to offer a full range of master's and doctoral programs to students in Pasadena, Houston, and Phoenix, as well as online to students across the country and around the world. Today, tens of thousands of Fuller graduates serve in churches and communities across the globe. And in 2021, Fuller launched its own digital learning platform, FULLER Equip, creating non-degree paths for learners in diverse vocations and allowing even more people to access the riches of Fuller's scholarship and innovation.

Yet from Charles E. Fuller's original vision until now, Fuller Seminary's core commitment has remained the same: equipping leaders with minds for thoughtful scholarship, innovative spirits for forging new paths, and hearts for the unchanging gospel of Jesus Christ.



## About the Fuller Seminary Seal

---



Fuller Theological Seminary was founded in 1947. Its official seal was developed in 1951, at the seminary's incorporation. The seal has served ever since as a representation of Fuller's mission and purpose, used to mark institutional documents and significant events in the life of the seminary. Along with the richly meaningful symbols of the cross, shield, and crown, the seal features Hebrew text taken from Isaiah 61:1, "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me to proclaim good news."

## About the Fuller Seminary Logo

---



The core of the Fuller Seminary logo is the icon, around which the framework for an identification system has been created. At the center of the icon is a three-paged book. The pages of the book form a stylized "F" shape, reinforcing the word "Fuller" and its biblical roots. Each of the pages forming the "F" symbolizes one of the three major disciplines—theology, psychology, and missiology—taught at Fuller Seminary. The icon evokes a feeling of movement, portraying how students take what they have learned at Fuller and share it with the world.

## Academic Regalia

---

Academic regalia is a modern representation of the everyday dress of both teachers and students in the early European universities of the medieval era. Their long gowns and hoods were quite practical. Over time, the uniforms evolved and became more symbolic than practical. Different designs and colors were developed to identify and represent various schools and degrees.

### GOWNS

Fuller, like most American graduate schools, uses black gowns for both master's and doctoral degrees. The master's gown is lighter in weight and has an unusual long sleeve hanging below the wrist, with an opening for the wrist. The doctoral gown is heavier, with bell sleeves and distinctive black velvet facings and three black velvet bars on each sleeve.

### HOODS

The master's and doctoral hoods are distinguished by length, shape, and the width and color of their velvet trim. Doctoral hoods are longer, with wider trim and a more open design. The trim colors vary according to the Fuller degree:

<b>Dark Blue</b>	Doctor of Philosophy (in any area of study)
<b>Scarlet</b>	Master of Divinity, Master of Theology (in any area), or Doctor of Ministry (wider trim)
<b>White</b>	Master of Arts (in any area of study)
<b>Golden Yellow</b>	Master of Science in Marriage and Family Therapy, Doctor of Marriage and Family Therapy (wider trim), or Doctor of Psychology (wider trim)
<b>Orange</b>	Doctor of Intercultural Studies or Doctor of Global Leadership

### CAPS

Like many American universities, Fuller uses the black mortarboard for all degrees. The tassel is black for master's degree candidates and gold for doctoral degree candidates.

### FACULTY REGALIA

The Fuller faculty have received their doctoral degrees from a variety of institutions around the world, so their regalia is quite diverse. European schools and certain older and larger American schools often exhibit more variety in the colors and designs of their gowns, hoods, and caps, while most American schools, such as Fuller, follow a standardized academic costume code.
